## AIR BRUSHING

**A** BANDONING THE TIRED tropes of security guards, entrance fees and walls, the second annual Figment exhibit appears on the Rose Kennedy Greenway on June 4. Billed as a “large scale collaborative artwork,”

more than 70 participants have contributed their visions to this conceptual takeover of public space. More radical than any abstract lump of papier-mâché, though, is the festival’s outright ban on commerce. Vendors and adver-

tisements are unwelcome, encouraging visitors to open their senses, not their wallets.
